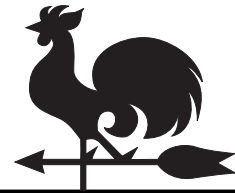

## Family Ultreya • June 21 • Pesotum

### Directions:

- *If you are coming down I-57*, get off at the Pesotum exit, turn left towards the Illinois State Police Headquarters. Go past the Police Station and take the 1st right. Go up over the tracks and straight for about 2-1/2 miles. The church has a big, tall steeple—you can't miss it! We'll be in the school bldg to the east of the church.
- *If you're coming down 45*, go through Pesotum and turn left at the corner just before the Police station (there's a big grain elevator there). Go up over the tracks and straight for 2-1/2 miles, the church is on the right.
- *If you're coming from 130*, turn right at the Pesotum corner and go for 3-1/2 mile. The church, with the big, tall steeple, will be on the left.
