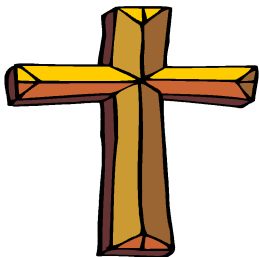

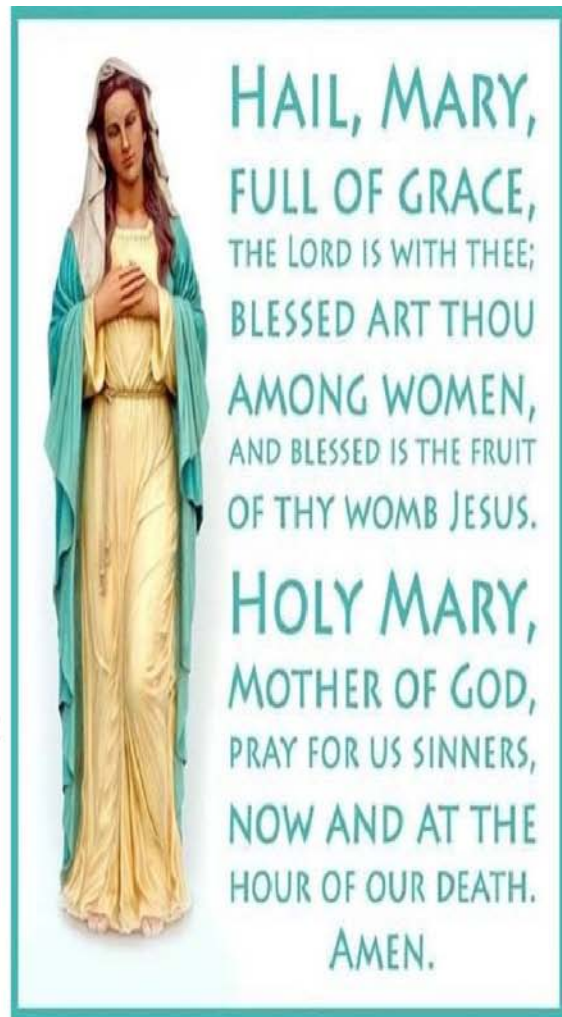
# MAY ULTREYA
